Comparative Legal Research Center

Understanding the legal world necessitates breaking the boundaries of local law, and becoming acquainted with other legal methods. The Ono Comparative Legal Research Center established collaboration agreements with world renowned legal institutes, such as the **Swiss Institute for Comparative Law, World Intellectual Property Organization and International Labor Organization**, for faculty and student exchange, international seminars, visiting lecturers, and faculty research, in Israel and in Switzerland, in order to expand legal knowledge and develop research skills in the field of comparative law. The Comparative Legal Research Center regularly holds conferences on comparative law and IP subjects of interest to the business and legal worlds. The Comparative Legal Research Center was founded and is directed by Adv. Shlomit Yanisky-Ravid and operates alongside the Center for Working Women and the Center for Employee Rights (and Employees Rights to Intellectual Property Developed at Work).

The Noga Center for Victims of Crime

The Noga Center for Victims of Crime offers pro-bono legal advice and representation for victims of serious crimes including rape, sexual abuse, child abuse, and murder. The Noga Center legal staff is supported by Ono Academic College law students and interns, making it an excellent training ground for the next generation of lawyers to care for victims.

The Noga Center believes that a profound change in the treatment of victims of crime, throughout the legal system, is long overdue and aims to make the system of justice respond to victims' rights. Through its extensive public activities the Noga Center fights for large scale change by lecturing extensively to raise awareness and promote victims' rights. The Noga Center also successfully initiates legislation and supports academic research in the field, and operates a legal clinic staffed by volunteer law students. The Noga Center is directed by Dr. Dana Pugach and Adv. Dikla Tutian.

The Center for Health Law and Bioethics

The fast and dramatic pace in which science and medicine have evolved in recent decades has created a great need for proficiency in the legal and ethical aspects of these developments. The Center for Health Law and Bioethics was established as a hub for education, research, policy-making advocacy, and publications in this ever-expanding field, combining Western, Israeli, and Jewish scholarly law. **Targeted issues include patients' rights, medical negligence, organ transplantation and donation, genetics, stem cell research, and public health.** The center is chaired by Dr. Gil Siegal MD and LLB.
